

Mounting instruction for photo wallpapers

Printouts

Unpack rolled printouts and make sure that received product is correct. Check if it is not damaged, defective, if the size is correct etc.

Recommended

A help of another person during sizing is invaluable. Draw vertical lines on the wall where edges of wallpaper should be placed.

Every single wallpaper produced by our company goes through a quality check point where the measurements and quality of the picture is being checked. It is very important that you do NOT start hanging the wallpaper onto the wall, before you check that the image and panels fit. To do so please put the wallpaper on clean and dry surface (floor).

This will give you an exact idea on how to start hanging the wallpaper.

Wall preparation and mounting instruction

- 1. Prepare your wall the wall should be free of loose paper or paint. It should be reasonably flat and clean. If the wall is dry seal it first with a coat paste prior to hanging (priming process which increases adhesion of the wallpaper to the wall).
- 2. To start hanging your wallpaper remember to glue the wallpaper panels / stripes, NOT the wall. Evenly spread earlier prepared glue with the wide brush. When the glue is prepared earlier, it avoids the uncontrolled time of wetting wallpaper. Also do not forget to glue the edges of every panel. Do not soak or fold panels.
- 3. Hang panels from top to bottom and brush using a paper hanging brush or damp sponge. Gently brush out any large bubbles to edge of panel. Small bubbles will disappear once it dries.
- 4. Hang the rest of the wallpaper, in the same way that you hung the first section.
- 5. The murals are printed on wet strength paper and can stretch by up to 10mm when wet and applied to wall.

Please ensure that you apply all panels with the same manner to ensure perfect match.

Important

It is necessary to keep the equal time of wetting every piece of wallpaper for about 1,5min after distributing the glue. Do it even with a stopwatch. During wetting every stripe of the paper is growing. When you lengthen time of wetting, it turns out, that the stripe may not match to another. Don't fold the wallpaper during wetting like it is done normally with other wallpapers.

To hold the wallpaper firmly against the wall use wallpaper roller or soft paint roller. Don't do it with your hand or cloth (it is easy to damage the wallpaper). Remove the excess of glue using a wet, damp, soft cloth or sponge.

ATTENTION!

It is a photo wallpaper mural. Although our photo wallpaper murals are made of highest quality materials please remember to treat them with special care (don't stretch or tighten it too much), be especially careful when hanging the wallpaper onto the wall for ex. concave corners, don't press it, because it is easy to damage it or make a hole.

Most often committed mistakes

Visible bubbles under the wallpaper - wetting time was shorter or glue was distributed to the wall instead to the wallpaper (wallpaper grew on the wall instead on the floor). These will partially disappear after wallpaper gets dry, but bigger bubbles will still be visible.

Visible joints – edges of the wallpaper have not been covered with sufficient amount of glue or have been too lightly pressed against the wall
